
Month 6 Raspberry Cheesecake





From fabrics 3 and 4 cut eight 2 1/8 inch squares.

From fabrics 6 and 7 cut one 6 inch square. From fabric 6 cut four 3 3/4inch squares.




From fabrics 7 and 8 cut eight 2 1/8 inch squares.

Make HST triangles edge to edge technique.



Place fabric 1 and 2 (6") squares right sides together.

Stitch along all outsid edges as per diagram using a $1/4^{\prime\prime}$ seam allowance.






One set will yield four half square triangles. Trim to 3 3/4"

Repeat with fabrics 6 and 7 for block 6B.

Make square in square blocks.






Draw diagonal lines on all of your 2 1/8" squares. Fabrics 3 and 4 for 6A. Fabrics 7 and 8 for 6B.




Stitch

Place right sides down on opposite corners of fabric 2 (3 3/4" piece). Stich on marked line. Trim on outside of stich

Stitch along all outsid edges as per diagram using a 1/4'' seam allowance.






Trim to 3 3/4".Make four sets for each block. 6A pictured.

Using fabrics 6, 7 and 8. Repeat for block 6B.

Layout and assembly of Block 6A:



Placing right sides together stitch sections 1 to 2 and 2-3 to make a row.

Press seams. Repeat until you have three rows.

Place row 1 on row 2, right sides together. Pin at seams. Stitch and press. Repeat with row 2 and 3.

Block is complete! :) Block should measure 10.25" at this point.



Following the same instructions, complete Block 6B. Note this block uses 4 fabrics.
