

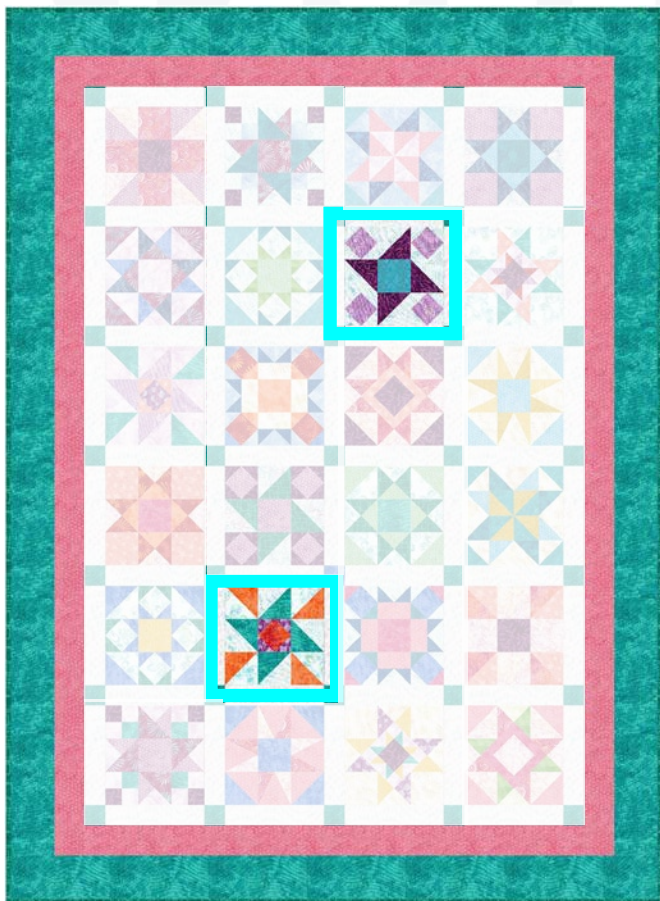

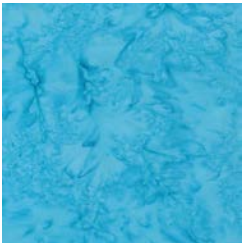
Month 7 Peach Cobbler

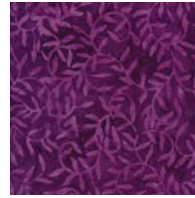

Fabric 3

From fabric 1 cut one
3 3/4 inch square.
From fabric 3 cut four
3 3/4 inch squares.



Fabric 2

From fabric 2 cut
sixteen 2 1/8
inch squares.

From fabrics 2 and 4
cut one 6 inch square.

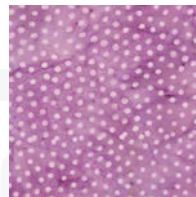

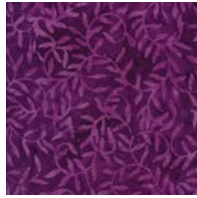

Fabric 7

From fabric 7
cut five 3 3/4
inch squares.



Fabric 4

From fabric 4 cut
sixteen 2 1/8
inch squares.

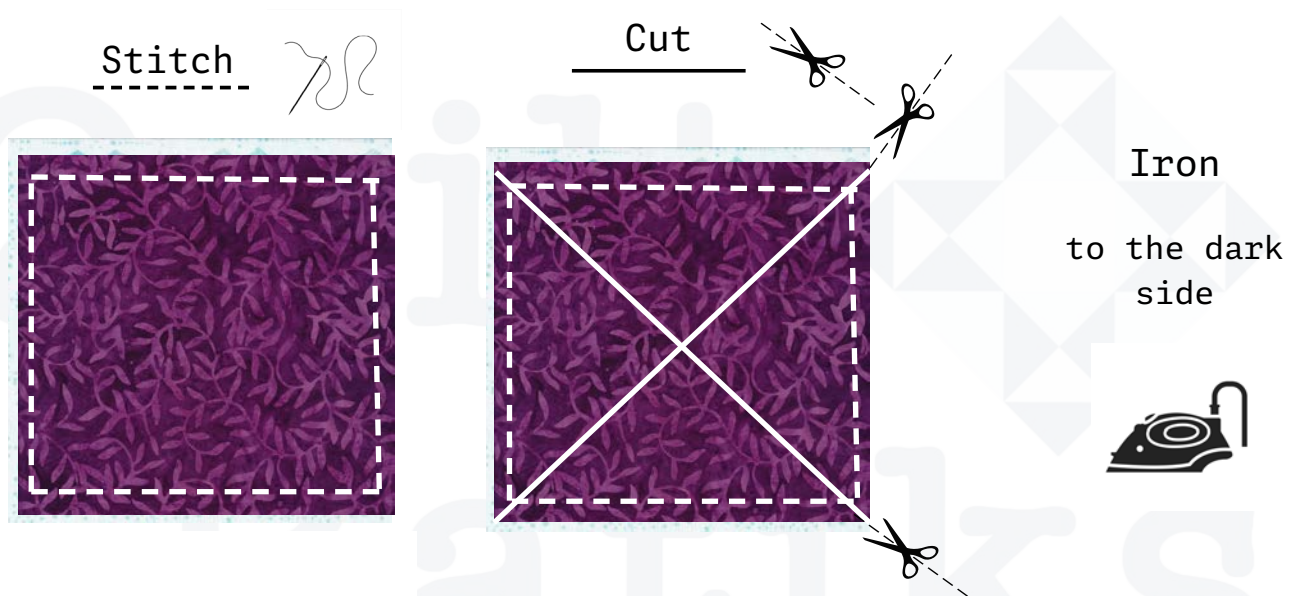
From fabrics 5 and 6 cut
one 6 inch square.

Make HST triangles edge to edge technique.



Place fabrics
2 and 4 (6")
squares right
sides together.

Stitch along all outside edges as per diagram using a 1/4" seam allowance.



One set will yield four
half square triangles.
Trim to 3 3/4"

Repeat with fabrics 5
and 6 for block 7B.

Make square in square blocks.

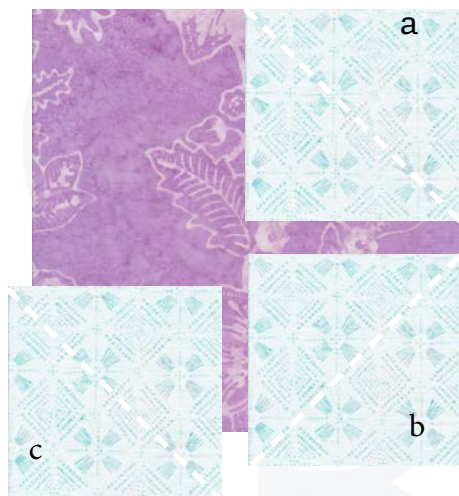
Draw



Draw diagonal lines on all sixteen of your 2 1/8" squares.

Fabric 2 for 7A. Fabric 4 for 7B.

Stitch



Place one 2 1/8 inch square right sides together (a) and stitch as shown. Trim and press. Work your way around the block (b,c etc).

Tip: Sew towards the bulkier end.

Trim excess and press.

Repeat for 7b with fabrics 4 and 7.

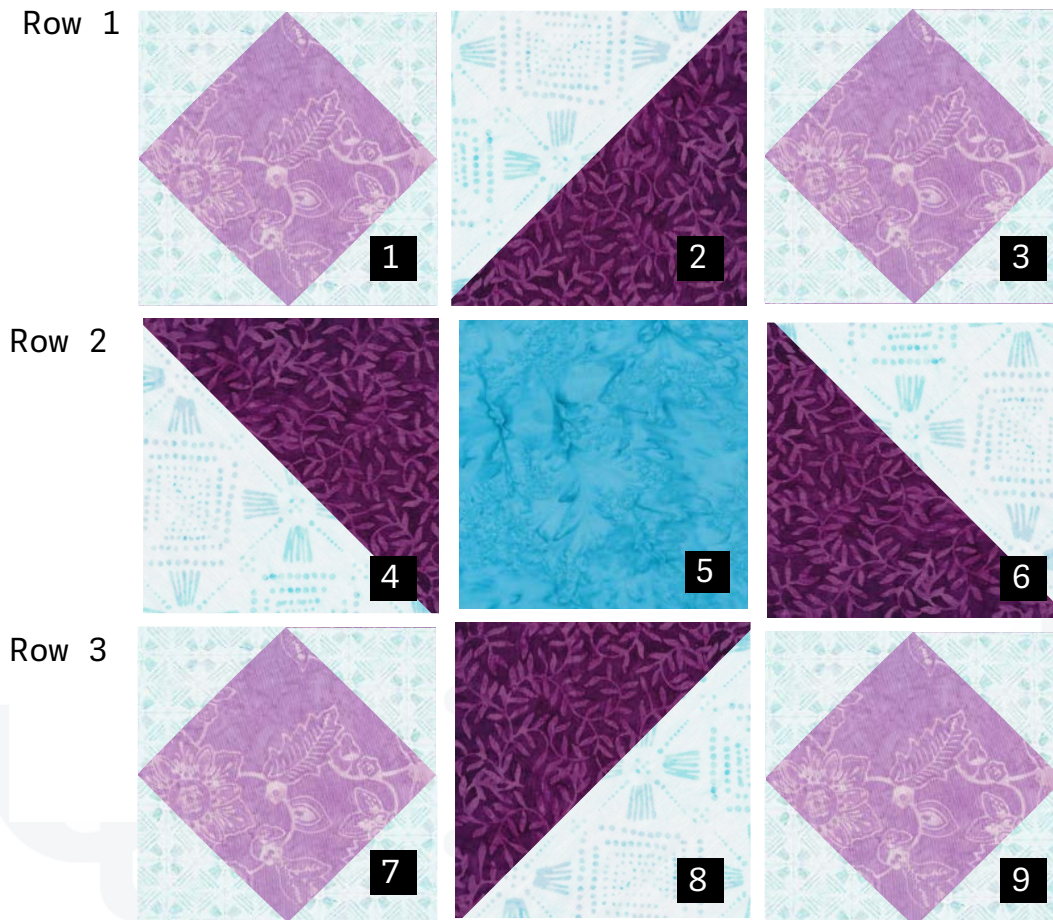


Press as you go.



Trim to 3 3/4". Make four sets for each block 7A and 7B.

Layout and assembly of Block 7A:



Placing right sides together stitch sections 1 to 2 and 2-3 to make a row.

Press seams. Repeat until you have three rows.

Place row 1 on row 2, right sides together. Pin at seams. Stitch and press. Repeat with row 2 and 3.

Block is complete! :) Block should measure 10.25" at this point.

Following the same instructions, complete Block 7B.
