





From fabrics 1 and 6 cut one 6 inch square. Cut two from fabric 8.

From fabric 7 cut one 3 3/4 inch square. From fabric 2, cut four 2 1/8 inch squares.


Mandarin 302

Make HST triangles edge to edge technique.



Place fabrics 1 and 4 (6") squares right sides together.

Stitch along all outsid edges as per diagram using a $1/4^{\prime\prime}$ seam allowance.






One set will yield four half square triangles. Trim to 3 3/4"

Repeat with fabrics 3 and 4.


Do the same for block 8B with fabrics 1 and 8, and 6 and 8.

Make square in square blocks.



Draw diagonal lines on all of your 2 1/8" squares. Fabric 5 for 8A. Fabric 2 for 8B.






Place one 2 1/8 inch square right sides together (a) and stich as shown. Trim and press. Work your way around the block (b,c etc).

Tip: Sew towards the bulkier end.

Trim exces and press.

Repeat for 8b with fabrics 2 and 7.






Press as you go.

Trim to 3 3/4". Make one set for each block 8A and 8B.

Layout and assembly of Block 8A:



Placing right sides together stitch sections 1 to 2 and 2-3 to make a row.

Press seams. Repeat until you have three rows.

Place row 1 on row 2, right sides together. Pin at seams. Stitch and press. Repeat with row 2 and 3.

Block is complete! :) Block should measure 10.25" at this point.

Following the same instructions, complete Block 8B.
